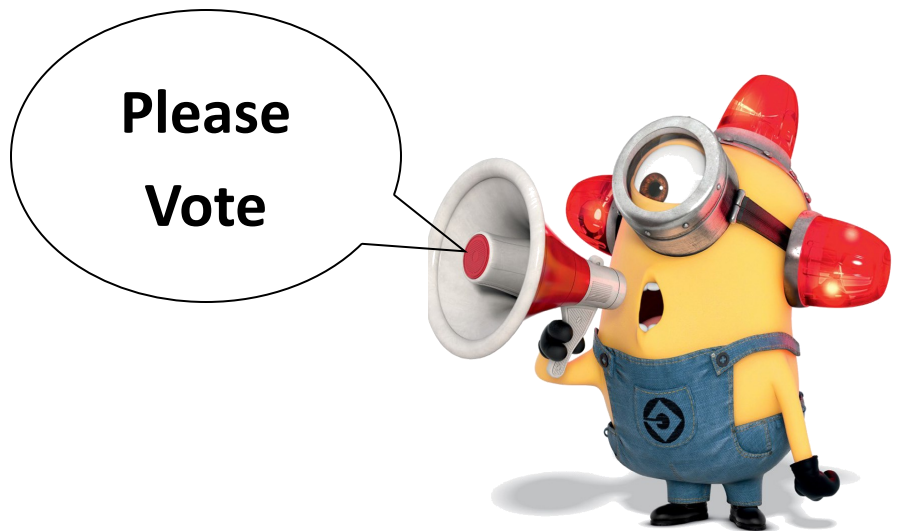
Recording Secretaries received no new nominations, and therefore will be reappointed subject to the approval vote of the general membership at this next meeting Saturday, October 8, 2016.

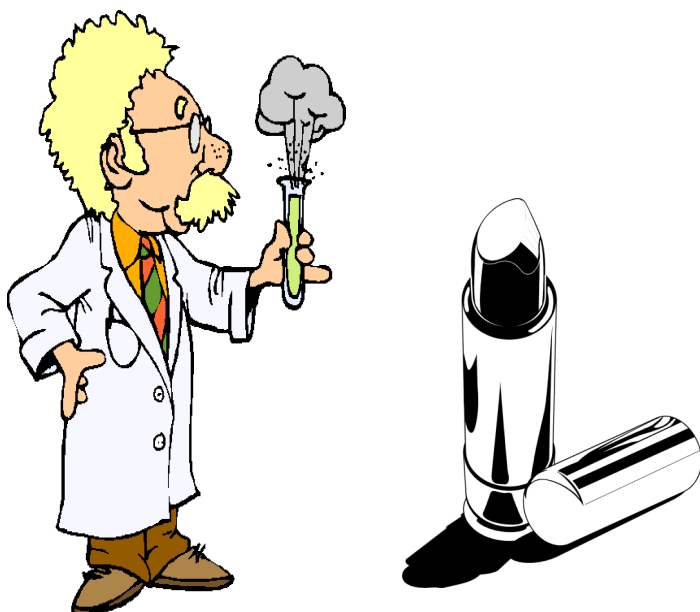

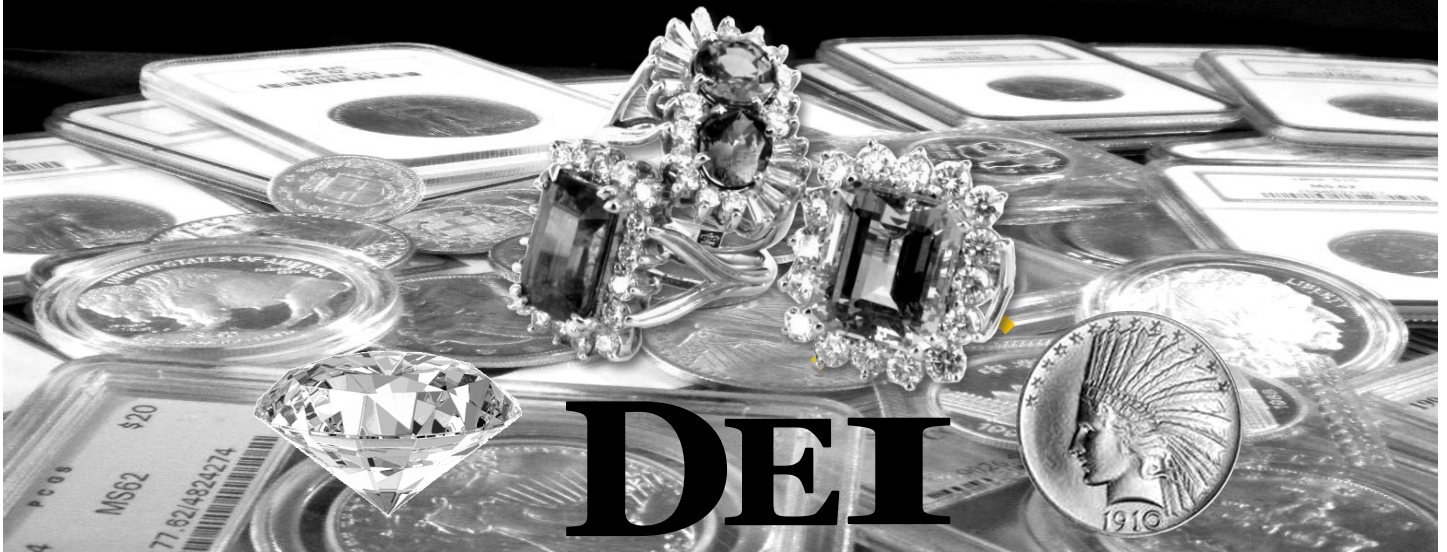
